The Norwegian Table Tennis Association (NTTA) hereby submits our application for organizing the European Veterans Championships in table tennis in 2023. We do so in collaboration and close partnership with Oslofjord Convention Center (OCC).

We believe that our concept for 2023 is quite unique, with the sports venue and accommodation on the same site. We will together with OCC create an «olympic village feeling» around the main event. Situated on the beautiful Norwegian coast there will also be possibilities for water activities, golf, multiple restaurants on site, visiting nearby cities like Oslo, Sandefjord and Tønsberg, etc., in addition to the competition itself.

The EVC 2023 will be an opportunity for the NTTA to generate media interest in table tennis both locally, regionally and nationally. This is the key for us to be able to recruite new players and to grow our sport in Norway.





Vestfold and Telemark County Municipality is very positive that a European Table Tennis Championship for veterans is planned in 2023 in our county - a place known for having the necessary infrastructure, facilities, knowledge and experience with the implementation of several major championships, cultural and sports events.

In our strategic plans, events are an important focus area and tool for achieving several of the UN's sustainability goals. Among other things, we see these events as a resource in area development, an important contribution to economic growth and a positive arena for inclusion and democracy learning among young people. We work to ensure that the events in our county have a green and sustainable profile.

The county municipality has its own subsidy scheme for large sports events, to facilitate an active and attractive region. The funds allocated through this scheme shall provide the organizer with support for the planning and implementation of the events. In 2020, we distributed a total of NOK 1.63 million.

The Norwegian Table Tennis Association was awarded NOK 100,000 to the Norwegian national championship in table tennis 2020, which was a test event and part of a long-term plan to be awarded the European Championship in table tennis for veterans in 2023.

Vestfold and Telemark County Municipality wants to support large events and be a partner in the planning and implementation phase. We work network-based and emphasize the development and sharing of organizer competence between different organizers, public administration levels and commercial and voluntary organizations. This with a view to the events in our region having high quality, good safety and a sustainable footprint.

We are very pleased that the Norwegian Table Tennis Association wants to apply for a European championship, and we want to support the application that the European Table Tennis Championships for veterans be added to Sandefjord municipality and Vestfold and Telemark county in 2023!







2000 m² spacious common areas inside Oslofjord Arena

(the multi-purpose hall)



EU/EEA citizens who wishes to visit Norway EU/EEA citizens do not need a visa to visit Norway, and can stay for up to three months.



In this area we are planning to create an active meeting and gathering festival square with entertainment and street food possibilities.




Flexible meeting rooms and space for ETTU and organizing committee.




