



**INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION SPORTS AGREEMENT
BETWEEN ITALIAN TABLE TENNIS FEDERATION
AND MALTA TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION**

Following the meeting held in Rome last 12 February, between the President of Italian Table Tennis Associations (FITET) Mr Renato Di Napoli and the Vice President of Malta Table Tennis Association (MTTA) Mr David Pace, and according to the existing cooperation agreement between the Italian National Olympic Committee and the Maltese Olympic Committee, the Parties (MTTA and FITET) agree and sign the agreement specified below:

ART. 1

The two Federations undertake to exchange documentation, information and sports materials relating to table tennis and collaborate on topics of common interest internationally, providing, where possible, any technical-training and organizational assistance requested from time to time

ART. 2

In order to support the competitive-sporting growth of the Maltese tabletennis movement, FITET will be able to evaluate, if the organizational conditions allow it, the possible inclusion of Maltese representatives in the Italian lower league championships. This may take place on the basis of regulations specifically defined by FITET for this purpose.

ART. 3

Players registered with MTTA clubs may also be freely registered for table tennis clubs affiliated to FITET without this being considered double membership for both Federations. These players, complying with the current FITET competitive regulations and rules regarding the registration of foreign players, will be able to play in the team championships of the following series of national level: A / 1 - A / 2 - B / 1 - B / 2
- C / 1 - male - A / 1 - A / 2 - B female with the exclusion of the Veteran and Youth Championships.

ART. 4

Players registered for MTTA affiliated companies that have an international ranking certified by ITTF, will be able to register, upon registration with a company affiliated to FITET, only to the National Tournaments announced annually by FITET with the exception of those who qualify for

the Italian Championships. The responsibility of the evaluation of the starting classification of the aforementioned athletes will be of the FITET Classification Commission / Technical Directors

ART. 5

In order to support the technical-sporting growth of the Maltese table tennis movement, the MTTA National athletes may be required to participate to the FITET national youth internships and/or 1st and 2nd Category Italian Championship and viceversa.

ART. 6

This agreement will be effective only if undersigned by the signature of the two Federal Presidents authorized by their respective Federal Councils in charge from the next 1st July 2020. The agreement will be automatically renewed form year to year unless notice of termination by one of the two parties, by written communication at least 6 months before.
